DAMBREAK SCRIPT

Round 1:Script 6

“This is a dambreak drill! I am calling from the Salt Lake City WFO to inform you of a possible dambreak at Hoop Lake Dam. We have verified that there is a major problem at the damsite from reliable sources. We were told that the dam is leaking and a break is possible. What do you think we should do?

Can you get back to us, as soon as possible, with a forecast for Lonetree, WY?

After the forecast has been issued: Call Back or wait for a follow-up call! “This is the Salt Lake City WFO. We received your forecast for Hoop Lake and have issued a Watch. I wanted to pass along some additional information supplied to us by the EM’s concerning the dam. Due to the ongoing drought, the water surface behind the dam is 8’ below the top of the dam. Is this going to change your forecast? Can you get the new forecast to me right now?

Information they should ask you (or at least verify location of dam) and your responses:

Name of River: East Fork of Beaver Creek

County: Summit

State: Utah
